As an international, multi-disciplinary, peer-refereed journal, *The Journal of Mesoamerican Biology* aims to provides a platform for the publication of scientific research in the areas of biology and ecology. In honor of the first publication, the Editorial Team is announcing an Open Call for its second issue, giving authors the possibility to publish studies they have carried out in the Mesoamerican region. For this issue, we will have Dr. Topiltzin Contreras Macbeath, Head of the Conservation Biology Research Group at the University of Morelos, México Co-Chair Freshwater Conservation Committee IUCN/SSC Steering Committee Species Survival Commission IUCN, as a guest editor. This 2021 Open Call for papers solicits high-quality proposals that will be evaluated in a competitive procedure.

Proposals for this Issue should include original studies and short communications and may be based on different theoretical perspectives and methodological approaches. The topic of the investigation must represent an area of high interest and relevance for the journal. Moreover, proposals should have a well-articulated theme and reflect, at an international level, the best work in a particular research area, either a well-developed area or an important emerging area, in which future investigation may be boosted by the publication of excellent papers.

To obtain information about the maximum length of the paper and detailed aspects that must be included in the proposal for Special Issue, please refer to the author guidelines.

Proposals for the JMB issues can be sent throughout the year to the following e-mail address (mesobiology.biovs@unah.edu.hn). These will then be forwarded to selected peer reviewers for evaluation. The proposal review process will take 4 to 6 weeks, with the final decision corresponding to our guest editor. The papers for the selected proposal should be submitted online and include 3 proposed peer reviewers. Papers will be published as soon as accepted to ensure faster publishing rates.
